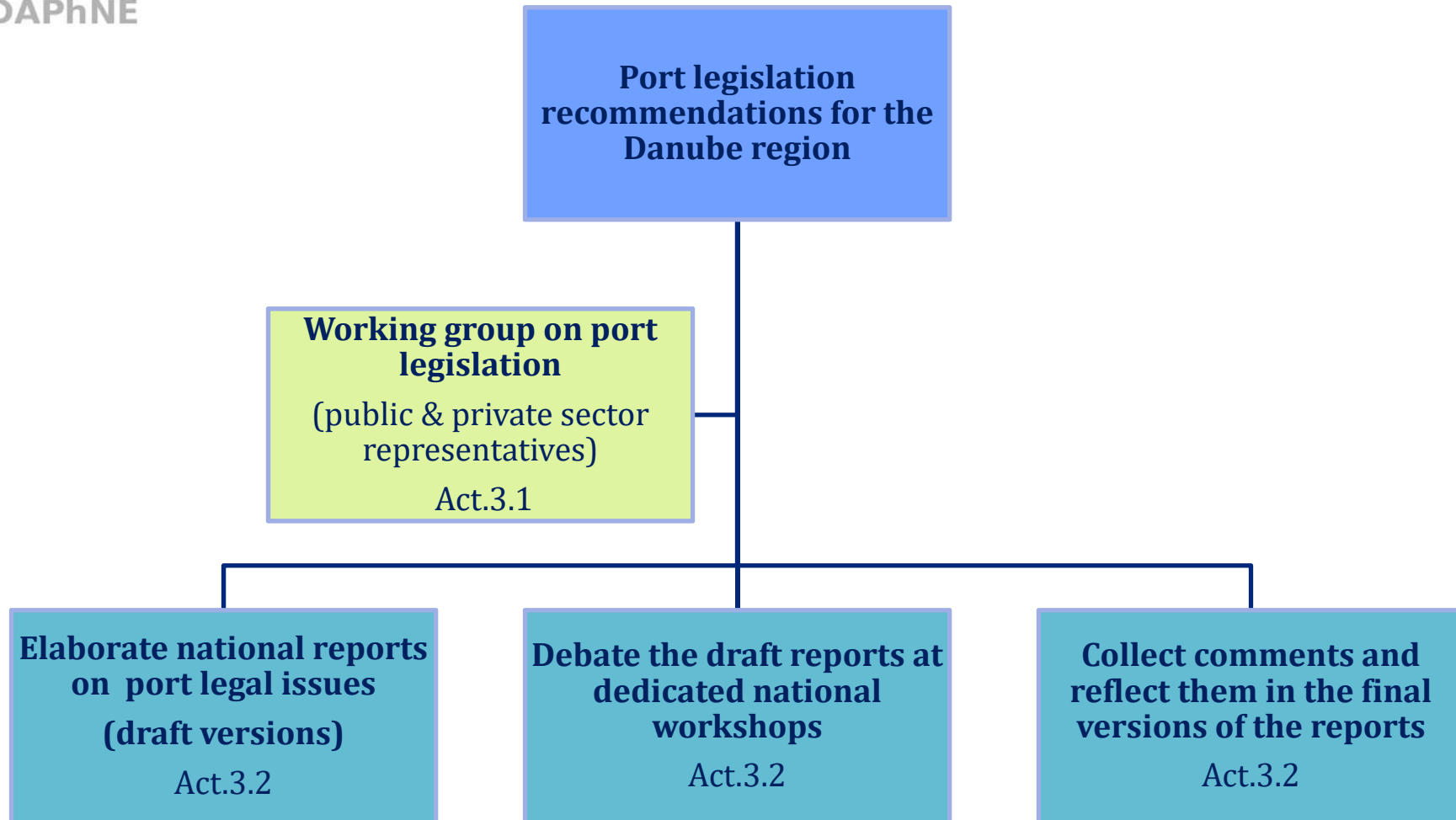

Next Steps

- Define the **structure of the national reports on port legal issues** and elaborate the template to be used by all 6 participating riparian countries – June 2017
- **Involve the ASPs from MD & UA** in this process, so that the final recommendations elaborated in WP 3 will also reflect input from these countries
- The **national reports** deal with **specific issues relevant for each country**, but they are analysed in a joint and integrated manner applying the same methodology
- The final **port legal recommendations** reflects the „**Same River, Same Rules**“ principle
