3Smart Project to Connect Five Countries

The main goal of the project 'Smart Building - Smart Grid - Smart City' (3Smart), which started on 1 January 2017, is to provide a technological and legislative setup for cross-spanning energy management of buildings, energy grids and major city infrastructures in the Danube region, said the Regulatory Commission for Energy (FERK) in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (FBiH). The total budget for the project is EUR 3,791,343.41.

According to FERK, this includes the development of a modular platform for co-ordinated building and distribution grid energy management. The developed platform will be installed at five pilot locations in five countries (Croatia, Slovenia, Austria, Hungary and Bosnia and Herzegovina) and a comprehensive cost-benefit analysis will be performed to verify the platform's performance.

The lead partner in the project is the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing (FER) Zagreb, while the other project partners are: Hrvatska elektroprivreda; Slovenian company E3; the Municipality of Idrija; Elektro Primorska, the Güssing European Centre for Renewable Energy; the Municipality of Strem; Energy Güssing; the University of Debrecen; E.ON Tiszántúli Áramhálózat; the University of Belgrade Faculty of Mechanical Engineering; Elektroprivreda Hrvatske Zajednice Herceg Bosne (HZHB); and the University of Mostar Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Computing.

The associated strategic partners participating in the project are: the Croatian Energy Regulatory Agency, the Jožef Stefan Institute, Slovenian local energy agency Golea, the Regulatory Commission for Energy in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the Hungarian Energy and Public Utility Regulatory Authority.

The project is funded by the European Union through the Interreg Danube Transnational Programme. According to Elektroprivreda HZHB, the total budget for the project is EUR 3,791,343.41, of which EUR 321,413.96 refers to Elektroprivreda HZHB.
