From Liszt Ferenc Airport (Ferihegy):

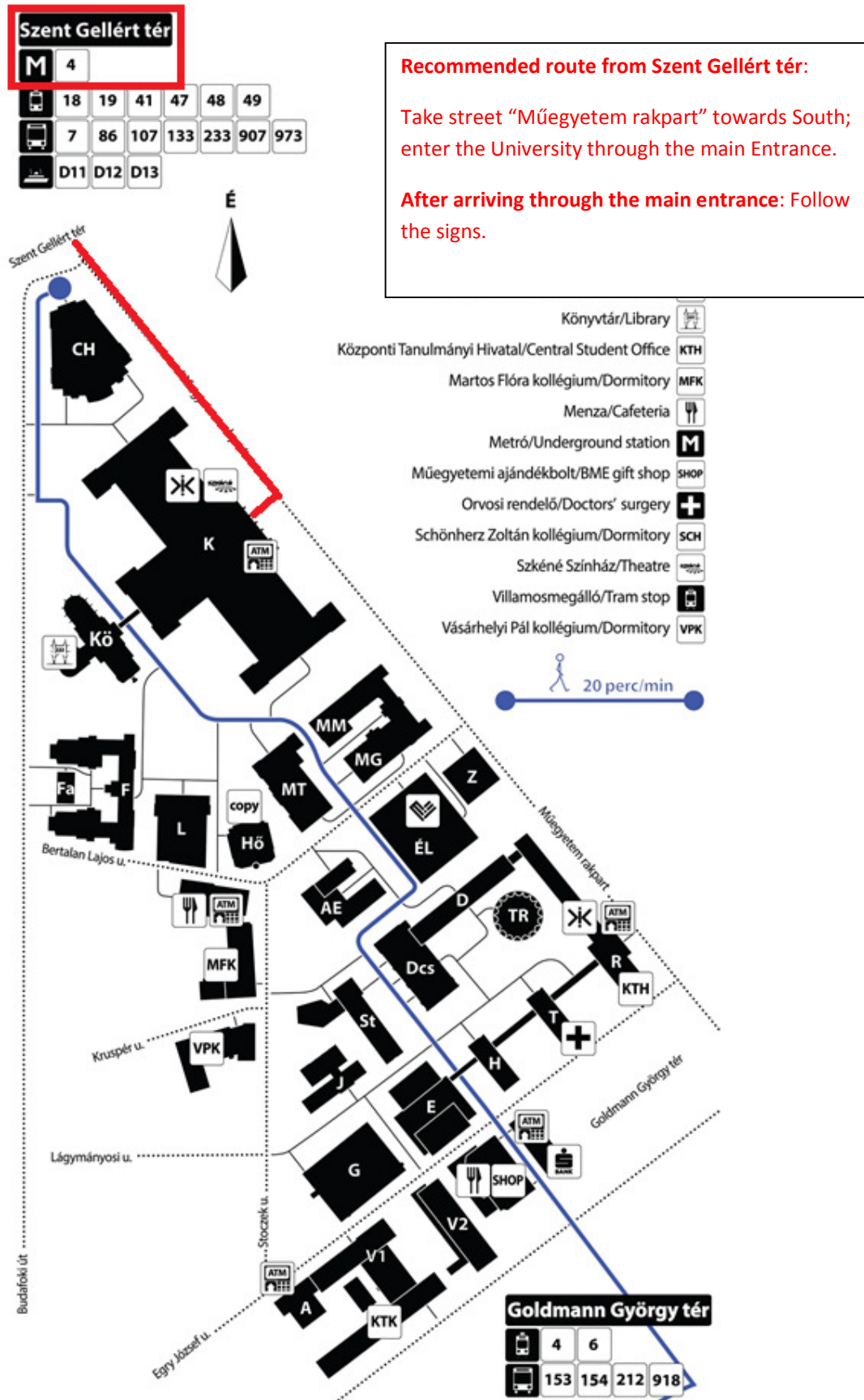
