A stream of cooperation



- 1st DTP Call – **54 projects** approved & under implementation
- within 4 thematic priorities – 9 specific objectives of DTP
- addressing different issues – certain **thematic connections**
- **integrated territorial approach** – partnerships involve mixed sectorial actors
- projects, outputs, results **not to be isolated**

## Capitalisation – the experience of South East Europe Programme

### How did projects benefit?

43% achieved greater stakeholder outreach

57% ensured output complementarities

54% made use of peers' achievements

47% benefitted from peer review

35 projects established links with on average 3 other projects



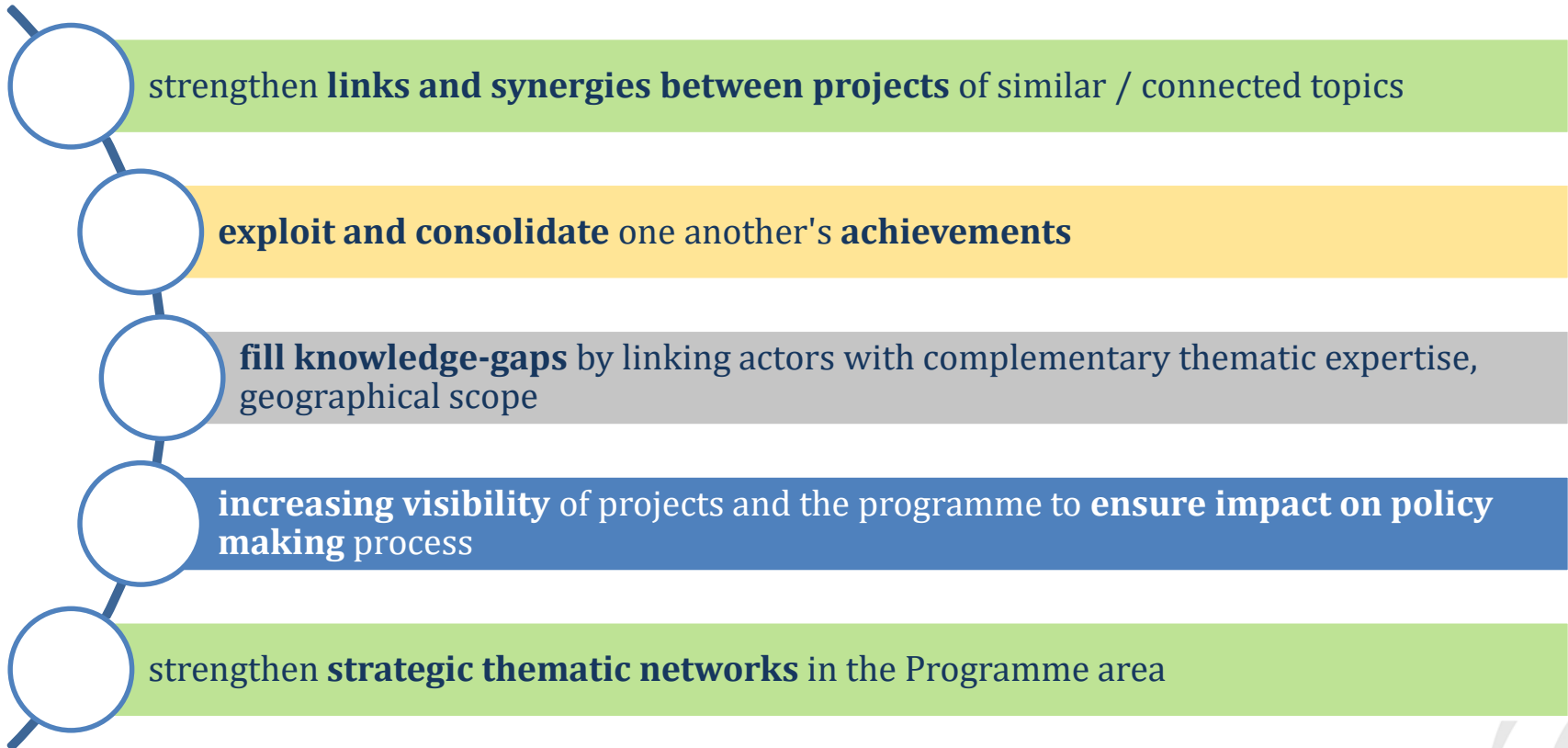
...so that now it can be used by both inland and marine vessels

...to ensure evidence-based migration policies for the future



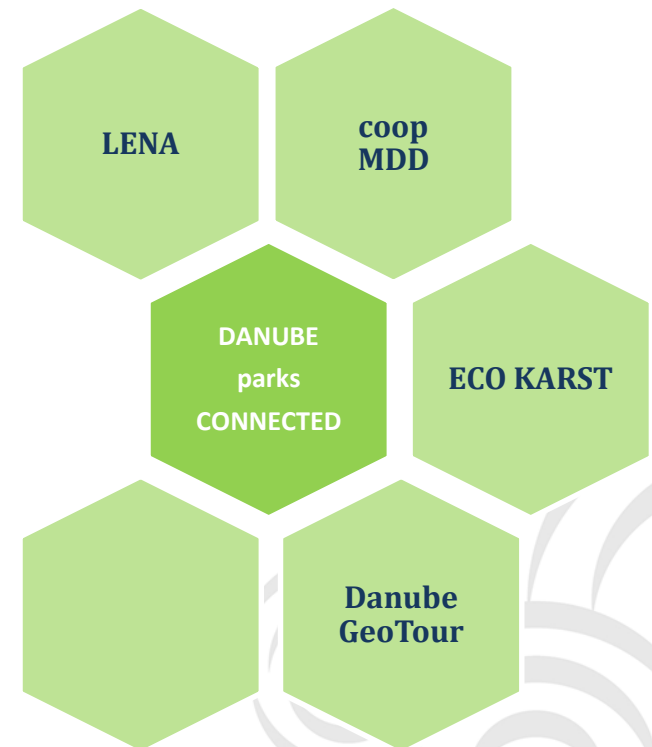
## Thematic Poles along 11 topics

- Increasing **visibility & enlarging** TP networks – EUSDR Annual Forum October 2017

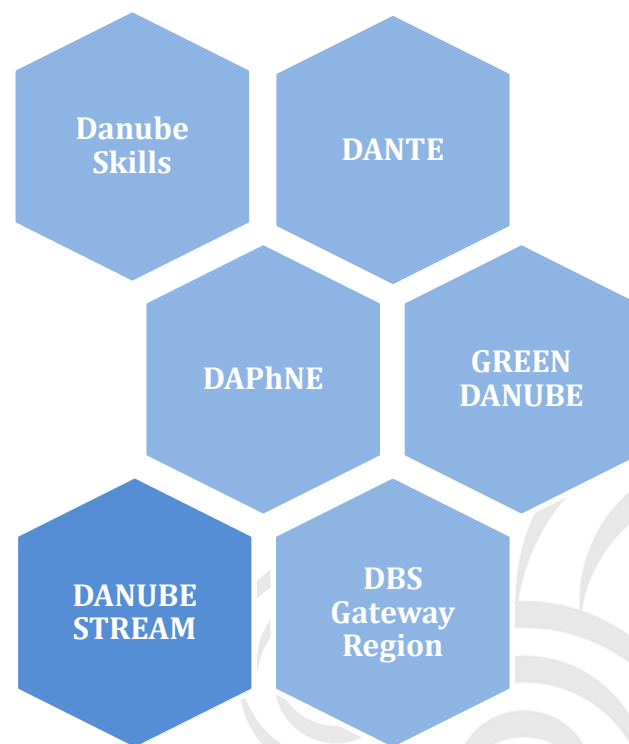
## Valorisation of natural heritage & eco-corridor management

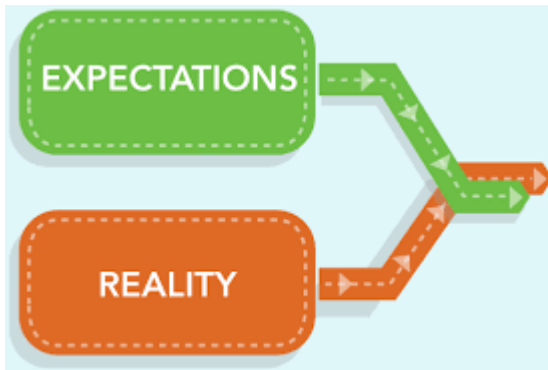
- addressing connectivity issues between National Parks along Danube river corridor

- protection and sustainable use of natural heritage represented by karst bio-regions
