






DINPI 20.09.2017

1st Danube Volunteers Day Duna-Ipoly National Park Directorate Szentendrei Island 20 September 2017



DINPI is inviting volunteers for a hard core, state of the art habitat reconstruction on a very rich dry grassland on the Szentendrei island. The area belongs to the Natura 2000 network, is owned by the Hungarian State and its trusteeship rights belong to DINPI.

Its main priority habitat is Pannonic Sand Steppes (6260), which is under constant pressure by newcomer invasive species (especially Black locust and Tree of heaven) and growing cover of native bushes (e.g. Crataegus spp.). DINPI has removed all of them in the last few years, however offshoots of Crataegus spp. have started to grow intensively. Our Volunteers Day will target these offshoots, removing them with all kinds of mechanical methods available...

Rusenski lom 28.09.2017

We have talked to the Director of Secondary vocational school in agriculture "Angel Kanchev" Obraztsov chiflik, just outside of Ruse, to invite 20-25 students and teachers to participate in the event. We plan to invite a local person to demonstrate traditional ways of mowing. Some of the topics for discussion will be: advantages of demonstrated different ways of mowing-using different machines and schemes; different species in this habitat; differences between meadows and pastures and how such could be maintained including support; what could be used the grass for. As participants are professionally involved or are going to be involved in agriculture we expect that they will have knowledge and skills to demonstrate.









NPDA 30.09.2017

"Restore breeding sites for the bee-eater"

We engage our Junior Rangers and the local public to restore the breeding sites of the bee-eater on the Braunsberg through removal of bushes and invasive species. A side event will be the instalment of nesting boxes for the "Wiedehopf" at Spitzer Berg.











Kopački rit Danube Transnational Programme first part of October

Nature Park Kopački rit has a educational trail called "Old Elm Nature Train" close to the Tikveš Castle Complex. Day for volunteer will be organized together with volunteers from local fishermen NGO "Šaran", NGO "Podunav", cycling NGO "Cikocoortura.


Removing of invasive species will be firstly done in mechanical way and then by hand be taken out reserve.
