Danube WILDislands Masterplan (1)

Review of the basic concept (its local application & testing)

Further development of the database and maps

Development of a **Danube-wide concept** during a reflection with key stakeholders (intl. Commissions, national water users, local land owners, media etc.)

Collection of **experiences and lessons** (opportunities and bottlenecks, willingness and limits, acceptance and support)

"Technical feasibility": re-wilding needs and constraints





Danube WILDislands *Masterplan (2)*

Long-term establishment of the WILDisland Initiative

Potential to establish a **distinct label** for Danube WILDislands (government meetings, intl. conferences, convention secretariats)

Compilation of main DanubeParks project results (strategy paper with database, final concept, testing, pilot islands)

Concept of a **follow-up project** to implement pilot WILDislands





Work plan of international consultants

- > Reporting and incorporation of Visegrad workshop results
- > Further development of the concept towards a *Masterplan*
- Support to PP managers to select and achieve pilot islands
- Consultancy on local lobbying support on intl. level
- Assessment of the potential and options for an intl. Initiative
- Further develop the **inventory** and **maps** based on PP input
- Provide support for developing the WILDisland database and
- Proposals for a follow-up project.





Proposed next steps by PP

Sept.: National Partner review of proposed pilot sites

in terms of ecological qualities (wilderness character and perspective)

Oct.: National Partner review of long list sites (inventory)

Nov.: Joint assessment with intl. consultants with the aim to

Identify easy pilot islands (1-2) and best candidates (1-5)

 clarify for those islands the key issues with local stakeholders (landowners, user rights, openeness to become a WILDisland etc.)

Jan-Mar 2018: Meetings with key stakeholders

April: Transfer results of your work to intl. consultants

June: Next joint meeting at Novi Sad conference to reflect progress.
