Research, protection and touristic use of the most important Iron Age Landscapes in Austria (AT), Croatia (CRO), Hungary (HU), Slovakia (SVK) and Slovenia (SI), among them the micro-regions of Großklein (AT), Strettweg (AT), Jalžabet (CRO), Kaptol (CRO), Poštela (SI), DolenjskeToplice (SI), Százhalombatta (HU), Süttő (HU) and Sopron (HU).

Activities

- Archaeological landscape research during the international excavation camps
- Development of new digital and analogue tools for tourists in the chosen micro-regions
- Development of an open-source digital research database
- Revitalisation of archaeological parks and trails
- Creation of new visitor programs for the museums
- International promotion of the most important Iron Age landscapes
- Development of strategies for the supraregional protection, research and sustainable use of the archaeological landscapes


