Danube STREAM key objectives

Different waterway management approaches in riparian countries offer strong potential to improve effectiveness

- **Danube STREAM will further harmonize sustainable waterway management strategies in a transnationally coordinated way.**

Faced with a dynamic river, commercial users of the Danube need up-to-date information on the waterway for their logistics planning processes

- **Danube STREAM will improve user information services by means of corridor-oriented web portals and tools.**

Results:

- Improved reliability of the waterway
- More payload on ships possible
- Increased environmental soundness
- **Higher attractiveness of Danube navigation**

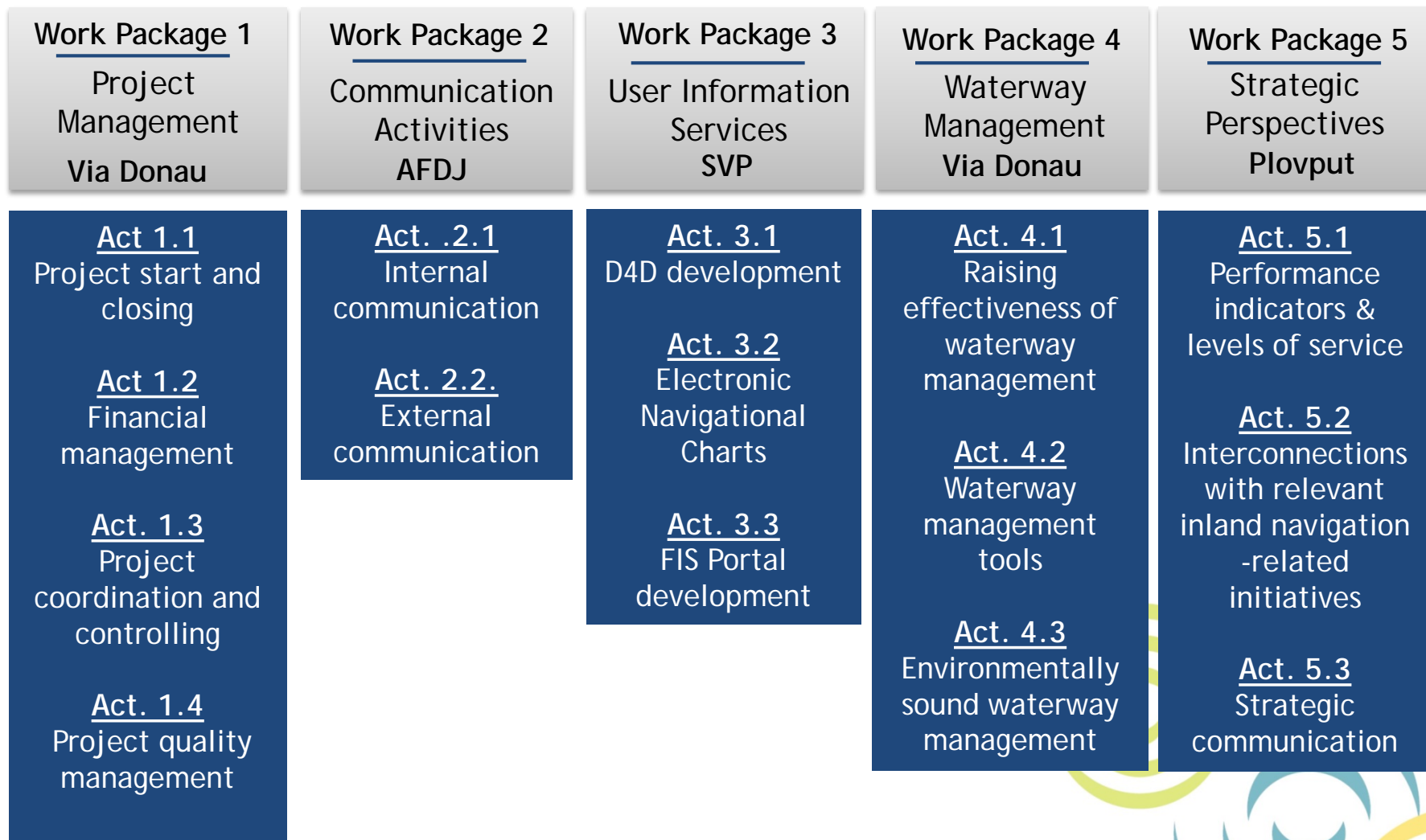

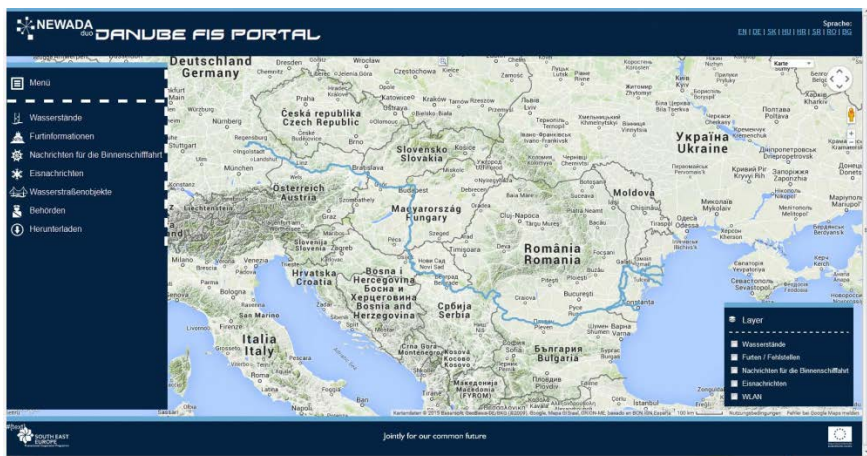
WP breakdown structure



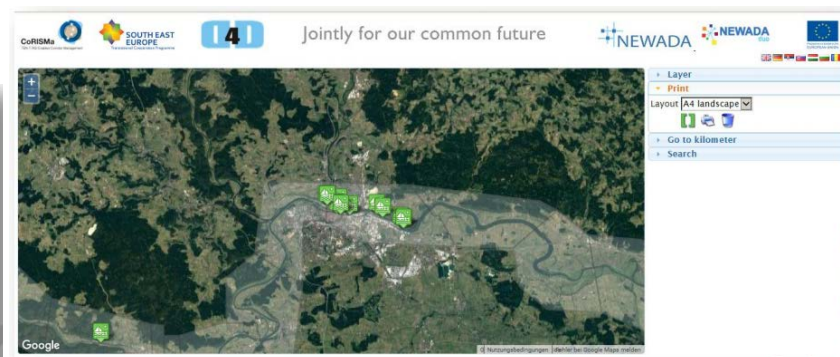

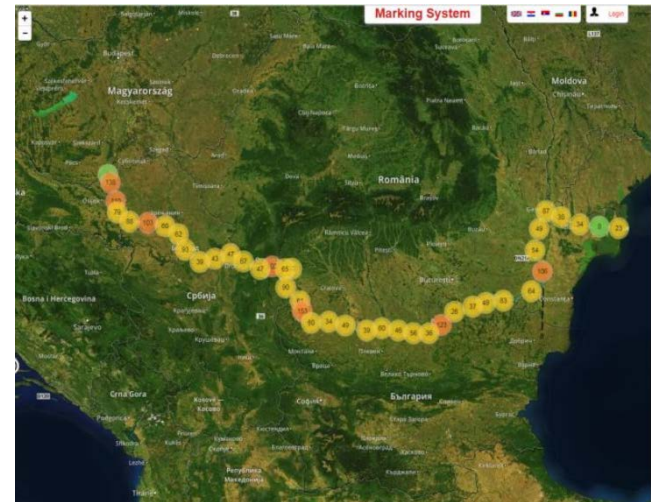

Waterway Management

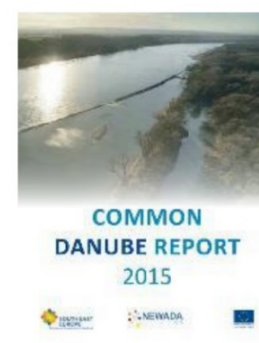
- Updated Levels of Service for transnational waterway management
