## Registration

## Directions to the meeting venue

#### By metro

The VIC can be reached with the U-Bahn by taking the line U1 (marked in red on city maps) towards Leopoldau and getting off at the station Kaisermühlen-Vienna International Centre.

#### By bus

The Vienna Airport Lines operate seven days a week, at hourly intervals, from 6:10-20:10. The VIC bus station is located on Wagramer Strasse in front of Gate 1. The trip takes about 30 minutes.

### By train

- The S-Bahn (Schnellbahn) from the airport to the City Air Terminal located next to the Hotel Hilton. The S-Bahn leaves approximately every 30 minutes. The trip takes about 25 minutes. After arriving at the City Air Terminal, change to the underground line U4 and then U1 to get to the VIC.
- The second option is the City Airport Train (CAT), linking the airport with the City Air Terminal. The trip takes about 16 minutes.
