ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TO THE MEETING VENUE

By Public Transport

Guests traveling by plane or train will unavoidably arrive at the train station "*Ulm Hauptbahnhof*" (Ulm Central Station). From there, you can either walk to the meeting venue (1,5 km, approx. 18 minutes) or take bus number 7 (direction *Willy-Brandt-Platz*) and get off at the station "*Amtsgericht*". See here for a <u>map</u> and the <u>timetable for the public transportation</u>. The journey will take 7 minutes, costs amount to 2,20 \in . Please note: Due to big construction sites around the Ulm Central Station the traffic guidance could differ from navigation systems information.

By car

Due to the event "11th International Danube Festival" which will run alongside the conference, the parking spaces provided by the *Edwin-Scharff-Haus* can quickly be occupied. Further parking facilities can be found <u>here</u>. Please be aware of the "European Green zone sticker" requirement for passenger cars in the cities of Ulm and Neu-Ulm.
