Incredible journey: one wolf's migration across Europe

Slavc is a wolf. In 2011, he began an epic 2,000 kilometre migration across Europe from Slovenia to Italy via the Austrian Alps. Several months earlier, he had been fitted with a collar that allowed his movements to be tracked in incredible detail. I talked to Hubert Potočnik, the biologist whose work made this possible



Iwo, a 5-year old bear collared in Poland, went from the Tatra Mountains through the whole Slovakia to Hungary in one week.



What are we interested in?

Danube Transnational Programme SaveGREEN

• Agriculture:

- fencing of several hectares of land without maintaining the zone of connectivity
- Problems with crop insurance in case the farmers have smaller fields

• Preventive measures - greenbridges:

- Multibarier effect
- Land ownership
- Green bridge aftercare (not technical, but ecological)
- The ecoduct ends in the agriculture field


