Theme: *Let's manage emergency situations!*

The theme of the 10th Sava Youth Parliament is closely related to the project called Water Contingency Management in the Sava River Basin (WACOM), whose main goal is to reduce the risk to people and the environment in cases of pollution or flooding. The WACOM project was co-financed by EU funds (EDRF, IPA) within the Transnational Cooperation Program Interreg Danube.

The Sava Commission, together with project partners of the WACOM project, strives to increase the awareness of people, especially young people, and teach them how to behave in such situations, thereby minimizing the danger to people, property and nature. If we do not act correctly in such situations or if the institutions in charge of solving such situations are not prepared and sufficiently trained, great damage can occur in threatened areas, especially in residential and infrastructure facilities, in water protection areas, and in extreme cases, even human life can be endangered.
