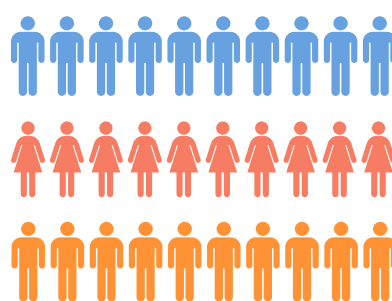

DTP programme finances projects contributing to a sustainable, interconnected, socially responsible and well-governed region thus paving the way forward for future generations of Danubians



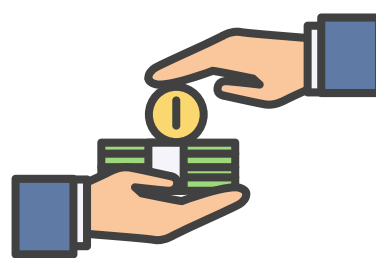
