



Selection of Current Projects

- **PROMINENT**: Promoting Innovation in the Inland Waterway Transport Sector (H2020 project, STC lead) –overall goal: develop sustainable energy concepts and technologies to foster IWT in Europe; contribution FHOO: Development of innovative e-learning tools for inland waterway transport (case study, different learning modules, train-the- trainer offers...)
- **REWWAY:** Research and Education in Inland Waterway Logistics (www.rewway.at/en): in cooperation with viadonau – competence center on IWT at our Campus. Goal of REWWay is to integrate inland navigation into logistics education and training to raise acceptance of the Danube as environmentally friendly way of transport by offering online high quality teaching materials, transport school labs, networking events, train-the-trainer offers.
- **DAPHNE**: Danube Ports Network (Danube Transnational Programe, ProDanube International lead) aims to facilitate a balanced development of Danube Ports as economic, well accessible multimodal hubs for the transport system of the region and to turn them into buzzing economic centres functioning as catalysts for economic growth and creation of high value jobs.
