Summary of Regional Stakeholder Meetings (D 3.2.3)

In the course of the initial desk research project partners collected information and analysed the current situation and framework conditions for Crowdfunding (CF) as well as the alternative finance market development and actors in each of the CrowdStream partner regions (see D 3.1.1 Regional Market Analysis on CF, D 3.2.1 Regional Profiles, D 2.3.3 Map of Regional Stakeholders).

In a next step, through the involvement of active and relevant stakeholders in workshops and meetings, results of the analysis phase were discussed and learnings for further development of the Regional Action Plans and a transnational development strategy for CF in the Danube Region were produced.

This document summarises the most relevant results from the stakeholder involvement activities, which will be a main input for the development of strategical visions for further development of CF environments in all project regions in the Danube area.

Learnings for Regional Action Planning (Summary of Stakeholder Inputs)

Please indicate the most relevant learnings from the regional stakeholder meetings for each question.

Experience of local stakeholders with crowdfunding

- There is a great interest from developers, students and young people to developing ideas for creating startups
- There is an environment for incubating new CF ideas
- There is still no example of a startup created in Bulgaria that has made a boom or so-called Unicorn
- A very good environment for the development of StartUps is the creation of coworking (shared) spaces

Difficulties encountered

- The local market is small, which making difficult to start new businesses
- Relatively small volume of possible funding
- Difficulties in managing the newly created business

Suggestions for improving the access to CF for SMEs

- Training for the process of generating ideas, presenting and managing business
- Creating platforms to finance small projects
- Improvement of the regulatory framework with a view to reduce the administrative work

Envisaged regional development goals

- Increasing the knowledge and capacity of students
- Reducing administrative burdens
- Involvement of municipalities, universities and banks

Suggestions for support actions

- It is necessary to conduct training for the process of catalyzing ideas and support the business development, in view of the involvement of new entrepreneurs
- Increased contacts and exchange of experience with platforms from the EU and the world
