



• Share of graduated female students (2008 bis 2018): 6%







Importance of lobbying and multipliers

• Chamber of Agriculture - Female Farmers

- Forest owner associations at national, regional and local level
 - \rightarrow low share of women in forest committees, but increasing
 - \rightarrow active support of women in forestry


