In 2022, Bratislava will take part in the celebrations of World Art Nouveau Days (WAND) for the second time as a part of the activities within the international Art Nouveau 2 project, supported by the Danube Transnational Program. The Slovak partner of the project is the Faculty of Architecture and Design STU in Bratislava, which has prepared on this occasion again a free thematic guided tour of the city for the general public on the topic "Art Nouveau in Bratislava" in cooperation with the Bratislava Tourist Board. The guided walk is aimed at the general public interested to discover the architectural gems of the Art Nouveau in Bratislava, which – at that time called Pressburg or Pozsony – was influenced by the currents of the Viennese and Budapest Art Nouveau. The guided walk will cover several buildings in the historic centre of the city and its close proximity, many of which are characterized by ornaments and sculptures of plant and animal motifs, often combined with historical elements. Among the selected buildings are residential houses, public buildings, schools and a church. The tour is free, but registration is required: http://visitbratislava.com/secesia
