PROJECT SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Increasing strategic knowledge for STI policy making in particular focusing Research Infrastructures (RI)
- Contributing to a monitoring framework for RI by e.g. developing and implementing a peer review approach and testing of developed guidelines and methodologies in pilot activities
- Enhanced regional socio-economic impact of RI by linking up economy and public administration as ultimate users

MAIN ACTIVITIES

- Dialogue workshops focusing on relevant regional, national and macro regional but also EU level policy fields involving also end-users of RIs;
- Special trainings for defined target groups, thus contributing to capacity building with an outreach to the entire macro-region and beyond the involved partnership;
- Collection of a dataset of qualified reviewers for RI assessments;
- Two pilot activities focusing on (1) peer reviews of nine existing RIs and (2) Ex ante assessments of three planned RIs in the Danube macro region;
- Dedicated dissemination and capitalisation actions contribute to the policy take up and utilisation of the results.
