



Elements of the EU Biodiversity Strategy

















- > Based on Natura 2000 and nationally designated areas
- > EU wide target, take into account specific situation in MS
- ➤ Integrate <u>ecological corridors</u> to build coherent network → specific reference to the role to <u>cross-border cooperation</u>
 (green and blue infrastructure) within ETC



Covering areas of very high biodiversity value & important for mitigation and adaptation to climate change, including all primary and old growth forest









EU Restoration Plan with 2030 commitments:

- ✓ Legally binding targets
- ✓ No deterioration of any protected habitats and species by 2030: trend to be positive for at least 30%
- ✓ Agroecology: Organic farming >25%
- √ Biodiverse landscape features >10%
- √ 50% reduction of use and risk of pesticides
- ✓ Reduction of pollution from fertilisers by 50% and by 20% their use
- ✓ Plant 3 billion additional trees respecting ecological principles
- √ Reverse decline in pollinators
- ✓ Restore 25,000km free flowing rivers



- By 2030 → restoration measures will cover 20% of EU's land and sea


