PUBLIC TRANSPORT

If you will arrive by train, bus or plane, you will probably want to use public transport to get around in the city. Vienna's public transport system is provided by <u>Wiener Linien</u>. The closest stops to the venue are:

- Tram (Straßenbahn): Börse
- Bus: Börse, Helferstorferstraße
- Subway (U-Bahn): Schottentor, Schottenring
