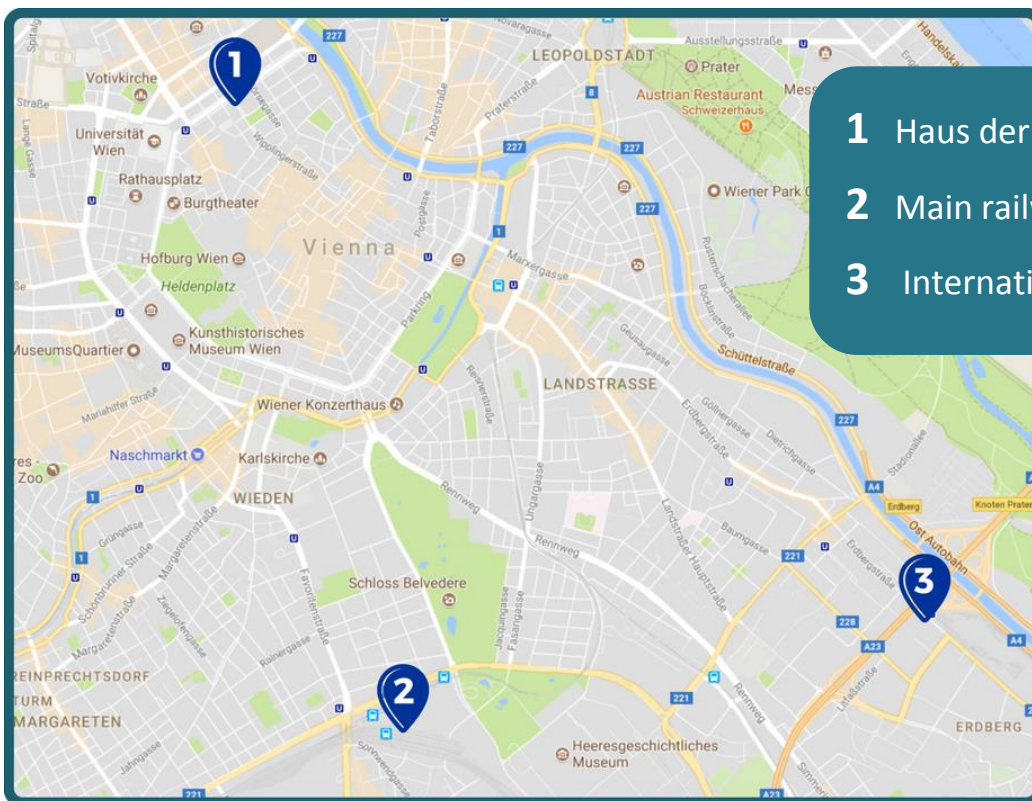

### PUBLIC TRANSPORT

If you will arrive by train, bus or plane, you will probably want to use public transport to get around in the city. Vienna's public transport system is provided by Wiener Linien. The closest stops to the venue are:

- Tram (Straßenbahn): Börse
- Bus: Börse, Helferstorferstraße
- Subway (U-Bahn): Schottentor, Schottenring

They have several combinations in terms of tickets, and we recommend you to browse their specific proposals for visitors in the capital – you will surely find the most suitable one. They also have a mobile app you can use to plan your journeys!
