- LIFE IS THE EU'S ONLY FUNDING INSTRUMENT FOCUSING EXCLUSIVELY ON ENVIROMENTAL AND CLIMATE ISSUES
- LIFE CONTRIBUTES TO THE IMPLEMENTATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF EU ENVIRONMENTAL AND CLIMATE POLICY AND LEGISLATION BY CO-FINANCING PROJECTS WITH EU ADDED VALUE
- 2017: 25<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY → CURRENT FRAMEWORK: LIFE 2014-2020 REGULATION
- OVERALL BUDGET 2014 2020: ~ €3.4 BILLION
- CALL 2017 BUDGET: ~ €373 MILLION





- LIFE FOCUS ON THE OBJECTIVES OF THE EUROPE 2020 STRATEGY, THE 7<sup>TH</sup>
  EU ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION PROGRAMME AND OTHER RELEVANT
  ENVIRONMENT STRATEGIES/PLANS (i.e. CIRCULAR ECONOMY PACKAGE)
- GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE: EU MEMBER STATES AND ASSOCIATED
   NEIGHBOURHOOD COUNTRIES (NC → NO PROJECT LEAD)
- POTENTIAL APPLICANTS: PUBLIC AUTHORITIES, PRIVATE COMPANIES, NGOS, UNIVERSITIES ETC.
- PROJECT DURATION ~ 3-5 YEARS, PROJECT VOLUME ~ € 500.000 € 5.000.000
- EU CO-FINANCING RATE: MAX. 60%

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLY IMPACT, NO PROFIT MAXIMISATION
- FOCUSING ON PRIORITY AREAS, MEET AT LEAST ONE PROJECT TOPIC
- EU-ADDED VALUE
- INNOVATION NO GRANTS FOR EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGIES
- PROJECTS FOCUSED ON RESEARCH OR DEDICATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF LARGE INFRASTRUCTURE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE





#### MINIMUM RULES OF REPORTING

- ALL (PROGRESS- AND FINAL-) REPORTS SHALL CONTAIN THE NECESSARY
  INFORMATION FOR EASME/COMMISSION TO EVALUATE THE STATE OF
  IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT, THE RESPECT OF THE WORK PLAN, THE
  FINANCIAL STATUS OF THE PROJECT AND WHETHER THE PROJECT'S
  OBJECTIVES HAVE BEEN ACHIEVED OR ARE STILL ACHIEVABLE
- THE DELAY BETWEEN CONSECUTIVE REPORTS SHALL NOT EXCEED 18 MONTHS
- THE FINAL REPORT MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE AGENCY NO LATER THAN
   3 MONTHS AFTER THE PROJECT END DATE


