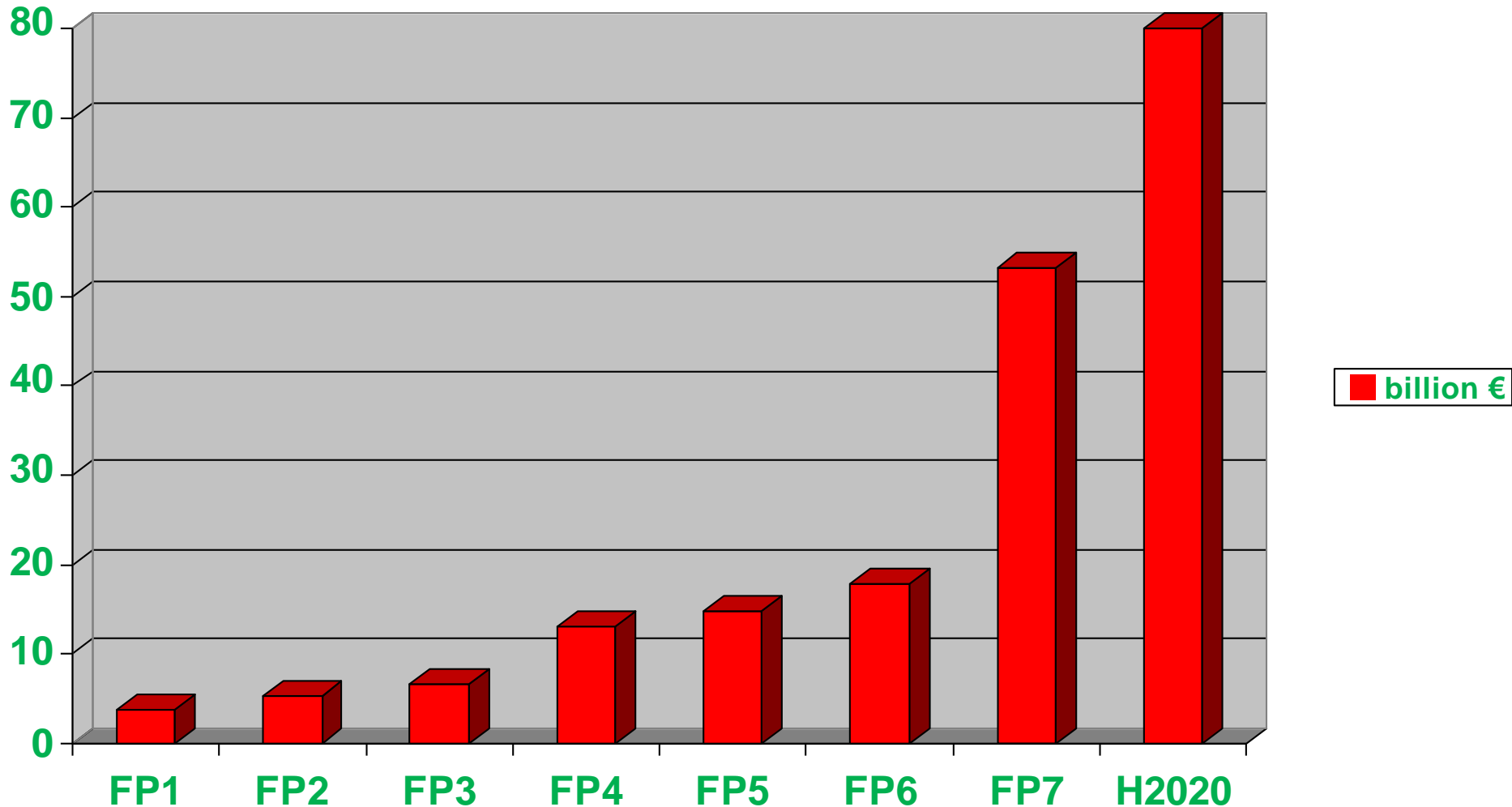
What is Horizon 2020?

- Focus on societal challenge: health, clean energy, transport etc.
- Open to participation: companies, universities, institutes in EU and beyond



EU Framework Programme Budgets from FP1 (1984-88) to Horizon 2020 ----> FP9

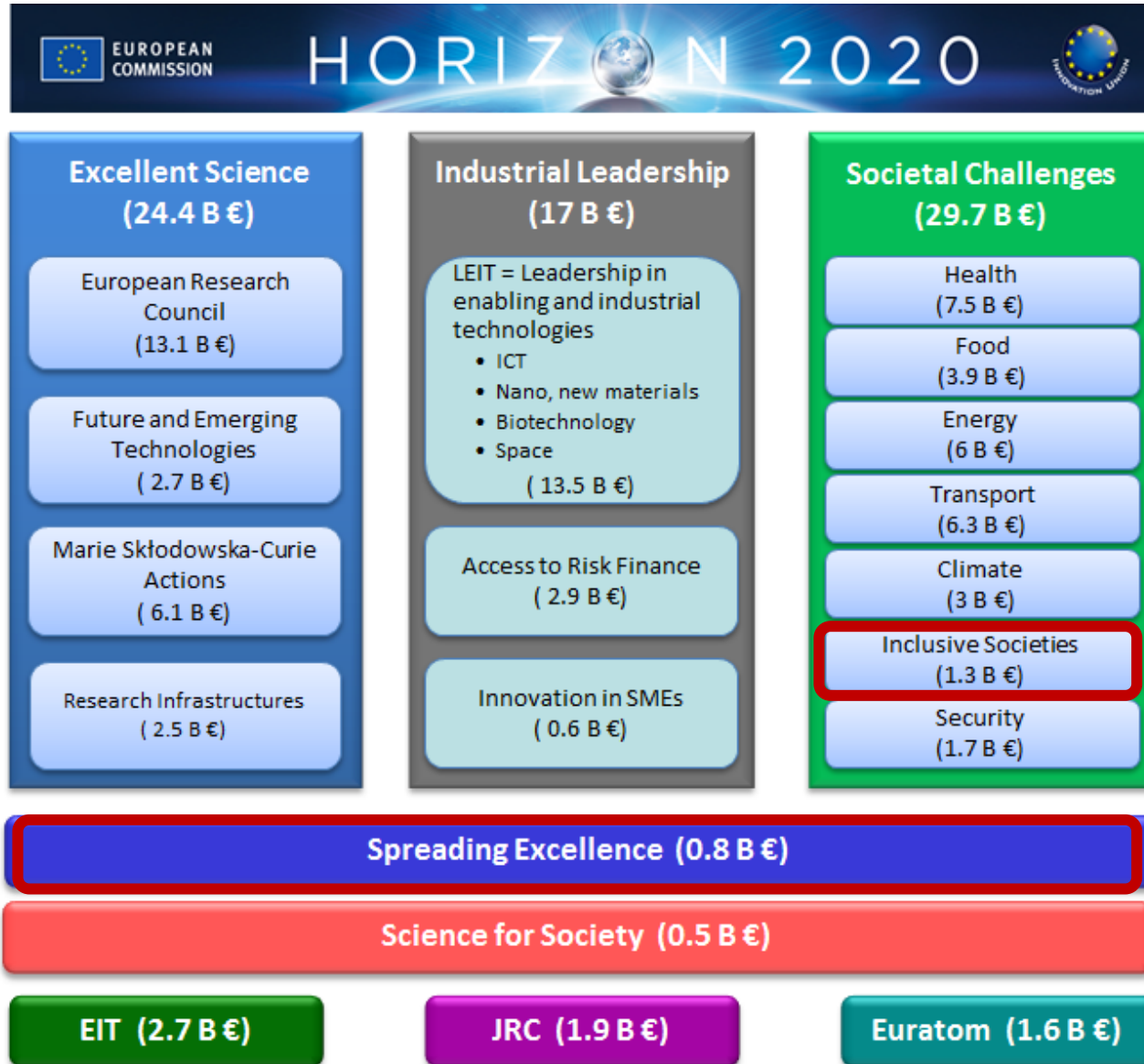

- Holistic, trans-disciplinary approaches to challenges and questions
- Less prescription, allowing applicants freedom to come up with innovative solutions
- Strong emphasis on expected impact
- Projects implemented through **consortia-based teams**
 - Minimum 3 Member or Associated States
- Project Duration 3-5 years
- **Work programme released every 2 years**

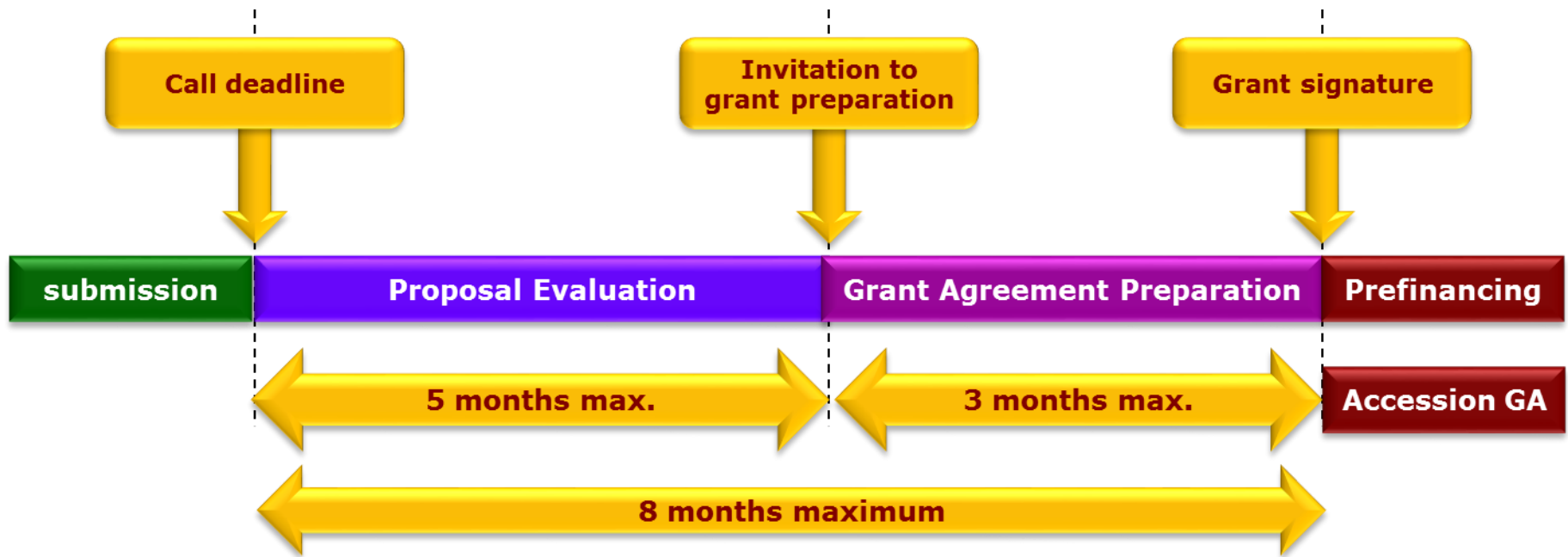

Overview of the process



H2020 max. duration to Grant signature:

- Maximum **five months** from call closure date to end of evaluation - until the date of informing applicants
- Maximum **three months** to prepare grant agreement from the date of inviting (informing) applicants until the signature of the grant agreement
- Maximum **eight months** from call closure - until the signature of the grant agreement.

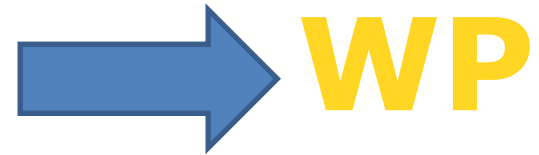

Twining aims at significantly strengthen a defined field of research in a university or research organisation from a Widening country by linking it with at least two internationally-leading research institutions in other Member States or Associated Countries.

Duration: up to 3 years

Budget: 1 mio EUR

Eligible costs: personnel costs, subcontracting (training), travel and subsistence costs, networking

Applicants: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia.
Partners: EU Member States, Associated countries, Non-EU non-Associated countries
